#### Lili Neuhauser, nominated for 3rd full term as Senior Warden

Liane Lunny (Lili) was born in Morristown, New Jersey to Robert M. and Liane v.W. Lunny. She grew up in Far Hills, New Jersey, initially on a farm and then the family moved to Oldwick, N.J.

Lili attended Far Hills Country Day School, the Gill St. Bernard's and then on to Drew University. Her great loves in school were always the arts, painting, and then art history and a rousing field hockey or ice hockey game! An idyllic childhood meant lots of animals, gardening with her mother, who had a fabulous vegetable garden, trips to her grandparents in Germany, where her historian father made sure that jaunts to every museum in striking distance were always on the itinerary.

As Schuyler was enrolled at the Tuxedo Park School, it was on to their board for two terms, her fund raising was put in high gear, along with designing many sets for school plays.

Eventually, having a child in school in the UK, meant lots of wonderful travel opportunities, which were very inspiring for her continued love of all things creative, painting being foremost. It was at this time that a friend asked if she would fill his seat on the Village of Tuxedo Park's Board of Trustees, for a one year term.
